

Coledale Public School Homework Policy

At Coledale Public School homework is considered an important part of learning.

Homework has been designed by the class teacher to:

- Consolidate classroom learning
- Facilitate parental engagement in learning
- Assist in building the confidence of learners
- Prepare students for high school (in Stage 3)

Teachers will set homework each week and report each semester in their school report. Through completing homework each week, students are building on knowledge, skills and understanding developed in class. However, if a student is unable to complete there will be no negative consequences for the student.

In certain cases literacy and numeracy homework will be differentiated to suit the individual needs of the student.

The indicative time commitment for homework (including readers) is:

- Kindergarten: 10 min per day
- Stage 1: 15 min per day
- Stage 2: 20 min per day
- Stage 3: 30 min per day

Coledale Public School recognises that learning also occurs outside of school through extra- curricular activities including creative, sporting, language, science and technology. The school encourages students to pursue their passions.
